

## **Poll Ticket**

The Poll Ticket aims to Put Students First in all areas of ASUU. Centering student experience on and off campus will allow us to achieve greater unity, progress towards a safer campus, and openness to all student voices.

**Unity:** The Poll Ticket will actively work to develop a more connected and resilient campus community. To further connection on campus, we will be dedicated to developing greater alumni networks, encourage the growth of clubs, advocate for the 17 colleges on campus, and be a bridge to administration for all student voices. With record enrollment of undergraduates from around the globe, it is critical that students are supported to find and curate campus communities. Unity to us means all student organizations and the 17 colleges will maintain stable and consistent funding to ensure students have a place to gather and have support to achieve their academic and career goals. A key pillar of this is investing more in student organizations, more comprehensive travel funding, and easily accessible and understandable information on how to request funding.

**Safety:** Students' greatest potential can be reached when they feel safe, belong to a greater community, and have easy access to resources of support on campus. Safety for the Poll Ticket starts with continuing dialogue with Commuter Services to make transportation more affordable, meet students needs, and provide safe options for on & off campus students. By engaging with commuter services, we will work to increase the accessibility of Safe Rides, work to expand their service to off-campus university housing, and work to create more accessible parking for all students. Understanding the weight of the information published in the 2023 Clery Sexual Violence report, we will also work with Housing and Residential Education and University Police

to combat sexual violence in campus housing. Lauren's Promise will also remain a pillar to combating domestic and relationship violence on campus, ensuring all victims are heard, believed, and action is taken as every student deserves a safe home to return to after classes, whether that be on or off campus.

**Openness:** The Poll ticket is dedicated to greater transparency between your ASUU, University Administration, the Student Body, Utah State Legislature, and Salt Lake City. Openness for us starts with ensuring consistent communication from ASUU Presidency to the student body on progress with our initiatives through a monthly newsletter. Another piece to this is openness to feedback and dialogue with the student body not just through the ASUU feedback boxes but also through public office hours for any student to voice their concerns. Openness also means empowering students to have critical dialogue with University Administration and ensure there is increased communications from administration to the student body on critical decisions that affect the future of the U. We will also ensure students understand how State and Federal legislation could impact their studies and communities at the U.
